Summary of Meeting:

CPSC is working with stakeholders to form an independent joint task force on IAQ and gas ranges. This task force would focus on making recommendations to various affected voluntary standards and code bodies to improve IAQ in homes from emissions from gas ranges. This was a working meeting of Group 1, which was tasked during the April 13th meeting of compiling a list of existing North American voluntary standards and codes that may be applicable, including section numbers when appropriate, and mechanism to submit a proposal. Before the meeting, Scott Ayers created a spreadsheet with suggested codes and voluntary standards from some stakeholders.

During the meeting, Group 1 discussed the spreadsheet and added several other standards. Scott Ayers will compile the list, organize the codes and voluntary standards, and email out to the members. AHAM, UL, and CSA staff will review their standards for applicable sections and requirements.

Group 1 will work over email to complete the spreadsheet ahead of the next main group meeting on Tuesday May 10, 2022 from 1:30pm to 3:00pm ET.
