This was a meeting for the CANENA working group looking to update UL/CSA 60335-2-40 from the current 3<sup>rd</sup> edition to the 4<sup>th</sup> edition. The next edition will be based on IEC 60335-2-40 6<sup>th</sup> Edition. The group is addressing comments from a ballot that closed in June 2022. The group is targeting completing comment resolution for a recirculation ballot in late April or early May. The group has met regularly since June, with in person meetings. Several virtual meetings have been scheduled to help meet the group's target timeline. This was the first meeting staff attended since the ballot closed in June.

The group focused on addressing the remaining editorial changes and discussed possible technical changes that could be addressed as part of the first amendment to the 4<sup>th</sup> edition.

The group completed review of the comments and the chair will forward the draft document to UL and CSA for publication. Staff expressed support of the final proposed new draft. The chair expects UL will need about 8 weeks to publish the 4<sup>th</sup> edition, placing the anticipated publication sometime in middle to late October.

The group will look to start meeting in October to discuss the first amendment.
