Summary of Meeting:

Staff attended the ASHRAE 62.2 Standard of Ventilation and Acceptable Indoor Air Quality in Residential Buildings committee meeting.

The committee discussed committee business. Part of the discussions involved acceptable distances for air inlets from mechanical exhausts, including exhausts from fuel-burning appliances. CPSC staff asked whether these requirements would supersede requirements in the building codes, specifically as they relate to carbon monoxide. The developer of the proposal said that the proposal would not affect code requirements.

The committee discussed other business including using an advisory public review process for the next revision cycle and changing expectations of indoor air quality standards.

The next meeting date was not announced.
