Summary of Meeting:

Health Canada requested that the ASTM F15.72 subcommittee review a proposal to add additional safety statements to portable fireplace labels. Specifically, Health Canada has found manufacturers recommending that consumers in Canada fuel their portable fireplaces with rubbing alcohol and other flammable liquid solvents.

Participants discussed the Health Canada findings. Staff shared that the standard should add a requirement making it explicit that reservoirs that use wicks shall be labeled to be used with fuels that are only combustible. Staff also opined that a portable fireplace with a reservoir that can accumulate water (and hence one could pour flammable liquid fuel into) would not be compliant with the standard. The participants agreed with staff's position. The participants agreed to revise ASTM F3363 accordingly and will work offline to develop proposed changes for a ballot.
