## Summary of Meeting:

The task group went through and addressed comments provided by task members on the draft standard. The task group addressed comments on the closure requirements, impact strength requirements, wick requirements, the leakage, and stability test. The task group also addressed comments on the requirements for child appeal. A member of the task group had concerns about the requirements for child appeal because these requirements state in part that oil lamps shall not resemble or incorporate any objects commonly recognized as appealing to and intended for children under 3 years of age, including but not limited to animals or plant material. The task group member expressed that animals and plant material appeal to adults too so these objects should not be excluded. CPSC staff indicated that the operative language in this requirement is *commonly recognized*, and that a determination would need to be made as to whether these images would appeal to children under 3. CPSC staff suggested using the criteria in 16 CFR on making age determinations. The task group agreed.
