## **Summary of Meeting:**

The subcommittee discussed a negative on the ballot for the bicycle grip standard revision. The commenter explained to the subcommittee that the hardness of the end caps should be 65 shore D instead of 65 shore A. Subcommittee members and staff agreed that the requirement should be 65 shore D, which has a greater hardness than 65 shore A. Additionally, the commenter discussed handlebars with significant inside and outside chamfers that allowed end plugs to be pushed into the end of the handlebar and requested that OEM handlebars instead of the handlebar coupons be used when testing. The subcommittee will withdraw the draft standard revision, correct the shore hardness requirement, and re-ballot the revision to the bicycle grip standard.
