## **Summary of Meeting:**

The International Code Committee (ICC) formed an ad-hoc committee to review code requirements for energy storage systems, including lithium-ion and non-lithium-ion batteries. This ad-hoc committee may review, consider, and propose requirements that effect residential construction and possibly consumer products. This was the kick-off meeting of the group. CPSC staff was not able to attend the full meeting.

CPSC staff joined the meeting late. The group discussed the possibilities of batteries added to home appliances such as ranges and refrigerators. While there are manufacturers trying to develop these types of appliances, no participants were aware of any large-scale availability of these products.
