### **Summary of Meetings:**

NFPA staff summarized the new requirements for venting materials that were added to the 2023 edition of NFPA 2112, *Standard on Flame-Resistant Clothing for Protection of Industrial Personnel Against Short-Duration Thermal Exposures from Fire*.

Task group members discussed possible safety hazards of allowing garments with uncovered venting material, which do not meet testing requirements for outer shell materials. Members discussed options including requiring all venting materials be covered, requiring testing of uncovered venting materials to outer shell material requirements, and full-scale testing of finished garments with uncovered venting materials. Several members raised concerns with the impracticality of full-scale garment tests.

### **Next Steps:**

A draft tentative interim amendment (TIA) will be sent out to the task group members for review.
