Summary of Meeting:

The UL 30 TC held a preliminary review meeting to discuss a proposed revision to UL 30 that would allow for a new design of safety cans. The proposal has not been balloted; it would not directly affect the flame mitigation requirements within the standard. However, the proposal does update the definition of “flame arrestor” and adds a definition of “valve” which could confuse test procedures that require “valves”. ULSE intended this meeting to replace a preliminary review ballot.

The proponent of the proposal shared a short presentation. The TC then discussed the proposal. Staff shared concerns with defining “valve” as proposed and stakeholders decided to change the term to “pressure relief valve” to avoid confusion. Staff did not support or object to the rest of the proposal as it did not otherwise impact the flame mitigation requirements in the standard.

The proponent will make some modifications to the proposal and submit the proposal to ULSE for ballot.

Next Steps:

Staff will review the ballot and comment, if necessary.
