### Summary of Meeting:

Contact CSA for more details on this meeting. The CSA Z21/83 Technical Committee formed a new TSC to develop and maintain a standard with the common and general requirements for all gas-fired appliances under the Z21/83 umbrella, such as gas ranges, gas furnaces, and gas grills. This common standard could incorporate safety requirements, such as related to carbon monoxide, that would apply to all gas-fired appliances. The TSC began meeting in March 2023. CSA intends the first edition of the general standard, designated Z21.0, to copy existing requirements from the appliance standards, but not change or add new requirements. The future editions of the common standard would then potentially modify requirements that would apply to some or all gas-fired appliances.

Staff participated in discussions on definitions for “listed” and “certified”, pointing out to the group that “listed” has a very specific meaning in the US building codes and that most of the occurrences in the CSA Z21/83 standards probably do not align with that definition. Instead, staff proposed using “certified”.
