Summary of Meeting:

This was the second draft meeting of the NFPA 30, *Flammable and Combustible Liquid Code*, Correlating Committee (CC). This CC is responsible for correlating all requirements within the Code. The CC considered the voting results of the other technical committees and whether the CC would need to make revisions based on the comments received. Staff submitted a public comment to NFPA 30 on May 27, 2025, that was accepted during the second draft meeting of the relevant technical committee and included on the second draft ballot. The second ballot voting period opened and closed during the recent federal government shutdown. Two negative comments related to staff's public comments were received on the second draft ballot.

The CC discussed and adjudicated all comments that could require CC actions. The CC made some changes to sections of the code that do not pertain to consumer safety. The CC determined that the two negative comments related to staff's public comments did not require CC action. One negative comment doubted whether ingestion hazards were within scope of the technical committee; the other negative comment did not provide enough substantiation to determine the rationale.

Next Steps:

Staff will attend future NFPA 30 meetings and continue to support the public comment staff submitted in May.
