Summary of Meeting:

According to their website, Vision 20/20 Strategy Work Group 4 “takes a focused approach on identifying tested solutions that conform to today’s safety standards what show how technology can have a profound impact towards our desired outcomes.” The work group is developing an idea to create a “fire safety product clearinghouse,” which would serve as a database of safety information that fire departments, community risk reduction specialists, and public safety educators could use to teach their constituents about fire safety as related to consumer products.

During the meeting, staff provided an update on work going on to develop new requirements for fire blankets and accidental activation of cooking ranges. The group also discussed educating stakeholders on recognized testing laboratories, cooking fire safety, other safety products, and general educational issues. Vision 20/20 is considering hosting a panel discussion focused on codes, standards, and product certification that this group would plan. Staff will participate in that planning as able.

Next Steps:

Staff will participate in future meetings as able; the next meeting will be scheduled later for some time in March 2026.
