NASFM hosts a monthly meeting of state PIO officers and others interested in Community Risk Reduction (CRR). Some purposes of this monthly meeting include sharing information on educating the public and discussing new risks facing communities.

NASFM staff updated the participants on various projects NASFM is working on including their development of an analysis tool to understand fire fatalities (residential and non-residential). Various state officials provided updates on activities happening in their states, including activities related to carbon monoxide, wildfire, community risk reduction, fireworks safety, and state fire data. The American Red Cross and the National Carbon Monoxide Awareness Association also shared updates on extreme heat preparedness and the upcoming CO summit respectively. CPSC staff updated participants on work related to fire blankets, accidental range activation, wildfire, fireworks safety, and flame jetting education.
