NASFM hosts a monthly meeting of state PIO officers and others interested in Community Risk Reduction (CRR). Some purposes of this monthly meeting include sharing information on educating the public and discussing new risks facing communities.

Doug Nelson will now lead the meeting as the NASFM staff has been changed. NASFM shared the stated goals of this meeting:

1. "Organize, prepare, and schedule materials and efforts for annual fire safety events throughout the year. Push this out to the states."

For example, the group could coordinate messages around Fire Prevention Week. It was announced that NFPA just released the theme of this year's Fire Prevention Week – Charge into Fire Safety: Safe Charging Is a Superpower.

2. "Respond quickly and articulately to current events. Send press releases and become a national resource for information."
3. "Organize and lead legislative information and resources for state officials. Single exit stairwells, fireworks, solar panels."

Staff from the state fire marshal (or equivalent) offices of Colorado, Illinois, Alaska, New Hampshire, and Maryland provided state updates. CPSC staff discussed field operations, upcoming Vision 2020 panel discussion on understanding product listing and compliance, and
