Summary of Meeting:

Staff met with ULSE staff, at their request, to discuss recently published and potential future revisions to UL 2849 relative to CPSC's recently published notice of proposed rulemaking (NPR) at: <https://www.regulations.gov/document/CPSC-2025-0012-0001>.

The following topics were discussed:

- ULSE staff shared information on the latest draft proposals including the topics which reached consensus and those topics that did not. Additionally, recirculation of topics is planned for specific technical topics which the Technical Committee TC project manager will communicate soon to TC 2849 members.
- Topic 4, from the April 3, 2026, proposal bulletin regarding battery compartments did not reach consensus in the latest ballot which closed in May 2026 because of adverse comments regarding 16 C.F.R. Part 1263 and UL 4200A with respect to lithium coin cells. This topic may not be recirculated with the others and may be presented to the TC at some time in the future, likely after the conclusion of the NPR comment period.
- ULSE communicated potential technical responses to concerns identified in the NPR and CPSC staff informed ULSE to follow the process for making comments if they choose to do so but making comments responsive to the NPR is optional and voluntary.
- ULSE indicated that they would send the link for the NPR to TCs 2849, 2272, and 2271 and may schedule TC meetings to discuss topics covered in the NPR.

Next Steps:

ULSE will schedule meetings with TCs 2849, 2272, and 2271, to discuss the NPR prior to the close of the comment period on August 24, 2026.
