#### **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

Background: ASTM WK70724 is a draft new voluntary standard for commercial electric-powered scooters for adults. It was formed in January 2020 and CPSC staff are active participants of this task group. A working group within the task group was formed to address the latching devices requirements of the draft adult e-scooter standard. Latching device requirements are meant to prevent any unintentional folding while riding and guard against potential lacerations.

Activity: The group discussed modifying the probe to be the one used by CPSC in the CFR and referencing 16 CFR 1500.49 for language on latching device accessibility.

Next Steps: CPSC staff will identify the relevant requirements from the CFR to provide to the group.
