MEETING SUMMARY:

The Connected Products task group continued and finished discussing the Toy Association comments to the ASTM F15.75 Connected Products Document (continued from previous task group and Subcommittee (SC) meetings) and clarified sections such as:

Section 5. Conformity Assessment Bodies: 1. Added and clarified language to ensure that this section relates to compliance with applicable underlying end product safety standards.

2. Deleted or clarified wording to ensure this section does not align solely with laboratory or security assessment standards.

The SC discussed the earlier CPSC suggested comment: List example cybersecurity global, cyber frameworks or baseline capabilities documents, i.e. NIST or Convening the Conveners (C2) cybersecurity documents for reference as an appendix. The SC considered challenges for best format and applicability of the suggested appendix since technology can move rapidly. Travis Norton of Bureau Veritas took action to send another draft.

The next ASTM Connected Products SC teleconference is scheduled for April 3rd. The other CPSC staff comment of: "Manufacturers should maintain good software and hardware configuration management..." sent previously to SC, can also be discussed. The SC will review the updated ASTM document towards resolution of all comments and for ballot.
