## **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

As part of an AHAM UL Annual Partnership meeting, Mr. Lee was invited to discuss information on lithium battery safety in consumer products as part of a battery technology session.

Mr. Lee gave a presentation entitled *Safer Battery-Powered Consumer Products*. Topics included an update of CPSC recalls and incidents involving lithium-ion battery products and a review of emerging hazards and technologies that can affect product safety. Mr. Lee also discussed a CPSC project to improve battery safety, outreach materials on the CPSC battery webpage, and staff participation in two federal working groups also intended to improve battery safety. Self-balancing scooters or hoverboards were used as a case study to show safety issues from products that were manufactured before a voluntary safety standard was developed specifically for E-mobility products. Implementation of the standard has shown to be effective, based on no known substantial fire incidents with products certified to the voluntary standard.

Mr. Hawk provided an overview of many UL standards and safety requirements in standards.
