Summary of Meeting:

This committee is responsible for reviewing all PHTA standards that are revised or created and any additional American National Standard (ANS) work products. At this meeting, staff monitored the committee's work.

The focus of the meeting was to discuss PHTA Standards that are in the process of being revised. The Chair of each Standard Writing Committee (SWC) gave progress updates:

- PHTA-1 Standard for Public Pool and Spa Construction, Design and Installation: The SWC have been working to incorporate plunge tubs/pools into the standard. The public comment period is expected to open May 2026, with publication of the standard in September 2026.
- PHTA-2 Standard for Public Pool and Spa Operations and Maintenance: The first meeting of the SWC is being held in April 2026. The SWC will be discussing change requests pertaining to water quality. The public comment period is expected to open May 2026, with publication of the standard in August 2026.
- PHTA-3 Standard for Permanently Installed Residential Spas and Swim Spas: The SWC is currently meeting and in the process of discussing change requests that have been submitted regarding cohesiveness between PHTA-3 and PHTA-5, Residential Inground Swimming Pools. The public comment period is expected to open July 2026, with publication of the standard in December 2026.
- PHTA-6 Standard for Residential Portable Spas and Swim Spas: The SWC is currently meeting and in the process of revising the standard. In particular, removing outdated and unnecessary language and language that is redundant due to updates to UL 1563, Electric Spas, Equipment Assemblies, and Associated Equipment. The public comment period is expected to open May 2026, with publication of the standard in October 2026.
- PHTA-11 Standard for Water Quality in Public Pools and Spas: The latest revision of the standard was published in March 2026. The standard is under continuous maintenance and the SWC is currently



discussing change requests that have been submitted.

- PHTA-13 Standard for Water Conservation Efficiency in Residential and Public Pools, Spas, Portable Spas and Swim Spas: The SWC is currently meeting and in the process of discussing change requests that have been submitted. The public comment period is expected to open July 2026, with publication of the standard in November 2026.
- PHTA-16 Standard for Suction Outlet Fitting Assemblies (SOFA) for Use in Pools, Spas, and Hot Tubs: The SWC is currently meeting and in the process of discussing change requests that have been submitted, with several going to ballot soon. The public comment period is expected to open August 2026, with publication of the standard in June 2027.

CPSC staff did not attend the Executive Session portion of the meeting, as they are not a voting member of the SCC.

Next Steps:

CPSC staff plans to attend the next meeting of the PHTA SCC, which is scheduled for May 28, 2026.
