Summary of Meeting:

This task group meeting was convened to finalize open items remaining in the draft standard. The group discussed all items and reached agreement on all items. Scott Ayers and Marcelo Hirschler will work together to create a clean and re-organized draft standard for task group review within approximately 2 to 3 weeks. The task group will then have about two weeks to review the documents. If no issues are found that would cause a task group member to vote negative, no further meetings would be required before the ballot. The final ballot version will be sent to the task group when sending it to ASTM for ballot.

Items discussed: updating the title and scope, finalizing definitions, deciding on which terms need to be defined and which should be requirements, agreeing to move the “significance and use” section, finalizing edits from the 4/9/2020 meetings, and discussing the re-organization of the document.
