Summary of Meeting:

This meeting of the Carriages and Strollers component of the ASTM F15.17 Subcommittee was held as part of the Spring 2025 ASTM F15 Juvenile Product Subcommittee Meetings. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss potential future changes to the ASTM F833 *Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Carriages and Strollers* standard.

Discussion included a summary of the work from the Stroller Wagons Task Group, which is looking at explicit inclusion of wagon-stroller hybrid products in ASTM F833. Subcommittee members provided specific comments on the proposed language. Subcommittee members also discussed incident data that CPSC staff sent to the ASTM F15.17 Subcommittee on March 14, 2025. The data included many incidents of frame breakage. Subcommittee members stated that this breakage is not detected in current ASTM F833 tests, but can be recreated with testing on a rolling road test fixture (EN 1888, *Child care articles - Wheeled child conveyances - Safety requirements and test methods*). CPSC staff encouraged the subcommittee to address a non-occupant entrapment seen in a fatal incident that was shared with the subcommittee. Subcommittee members are planning a meeting for the Data Analysis Task Group to further discuss incident data; ASTM added interested parties to the task group, which CPSC staff is already participating in. Subcommittee members also discussed a letter that CPSC staff sent to ASTM F15.12 (copied to ASTM F15.17) on April 28, 2025 regarding firmness and breathability, which may impact carriages and strollers.

Next Steps:

The Stroller Wagons Task Group and Data Analysis Task Group are planning to meet, but no dates have been set at this time. The Carriages and Strollers component of the ASTM F15.17 Subcommittee is likely to hold its next meeting as part of the Fall 2025 ASTM F15 Juvenile Product Subcommittee Meetings, which have not been scheduled at this time.
