SUMMARY OF MEETING:

- Purpose of the meeting was to provide an update of the status of UL 4600 standard for autonomous products.
 - \circ Publication of first version on 4/1/2020.
 - o UL 4600 is an ANSI accredited standard
- UL staff provided review of how to submit proposed changes and the proposal request process. Suggestions should provide as much detail as possible to support work on revision.

• Going forward:

- o UL standards are effective indefinitely. There is no requirement for periodic reapproval and is not subject to any renewal cycle.
- Already received comments proposing additions, changes, or edits during the initial approval process – ongoing revisions after initial publication were anticipated.
- o Plan to review/work on comments/suggestions submitted during standard balloting process.
