SUBJECT: Meeting with UL Research Institute's Digital Safety Research Institute (DSRI) to discuss artificial intelligence topics of mutual interest

Summary of Meeting: Dr. Crisman shared DSRI's recent chatbot project details and CPSC staff also discussed some past and current emerging technology efforts. DSRI's work focused on chatbots capabilities to influence addictive and violent behaviors, AI tools classification, and building AI assessment tools. DSRI also shared joint projects such as with Common Sense Media on efforts for child safety in generative AI.

CPSC staff reiterated CPSC Chairman Feldman discussing the types of hazards/harms we look for in: "Chairman Response to Senators' Letter for AI in Children's Toys¹" and "Chairman's Keynote Remarks at Toy Fair²", how we share physical safety risks with UL, and how CPSC enforces the Toy Standard (under Section 106 of the CPSIA) when looking at children's chatbots. *UL 3115: Outline of Investigation (OoI) for Safety of AI-Based Products* was mentioned as being followed by DSRI with current CPSC staff participating in that developing safety criteria.

DSRI also discussed their AI incident databases such as the Artificial Intelligence Incident Database (AIID)³. Other DSRI projects involving consumer medical, wellness or therapeutic chatbots, including their possible psychological and suicide risks were also discussed. DSRI asked if a Memorandum of Understanding is needed for continued discussions and CPSC staff responded not at this time.

Next Steps:

DSRI and CPSC staff expressed interest in future and possibly monthly regular discussions. DSRI will then send out possible future meeting dates for CPSC staff confirmation.
