Summary of Meeting:

This task group covers topics related to anti-tip device material degradation and conditioning for ASTM F3096, *Standard Performance Specification for Tipover Restraint(s) Used with Clothing Storage Unit(s)*. In this meeting, task group members continued discussion on UV testing of plastic cable tie-style and strap-style anti-tip devices. The task group chair recapped recent CPSC recalls and product warnings for anti-tip devices and provided a testing summary. Task group members discussed take-aways from testing; CPSC staff said that one sample clearly degraded, which they think is enough to justify UV conditioning of samples prior to strength testing. Task group members discussed a potential bending test to evaluate anti-tip device brittleness; task group members are not aware of an existing test for this. Task group members plan to draft a test specification in a small working group with a subset of task group members; CPSC staff joined this group.

Next Steps: The next full task group meeting is scheduled for August 6, 2026 (task group is switching to meeting every other month). The task group plans to schedule meetings for the small working group on test specification in the interim.
