**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

This meeting was led by Paul Ware, Subcommittee Chair for Infant Bath Tubs. After the approval of the agenda and previous meeting minutes, four ballot results were discussed:

- (1) Revised Introduction was approved.
- (2) Removal of CPSIA reference was approved.
- (3) Marking and Labeling had one negative that the Subcommittee found non-persuasive.
- (4) Resistance to Collapse had negative votes that have been addressed. This will be re-balloted before releasing the Administrative Hold on the other 3 items.

The New Business discussed a new product with a stand. The subcommittee chair indicated the product meets the definition of a bath tub because the seat holds water for bathing. The product fails the bath tub regulation because it has restraints. A new task group was formed to explore stability requirements for bath tubs on stands. CPSC staff are on the task group.
