Summary of Meeting:

The subcommittee is drafting a standard containing performance requirements and warnings for wearable infant blankets. The participants on the call discussed how to resolve several negative votes on the latest ballot that closed on November 3, 2025. Many comments and negative votes were discussed in a prior meeting on November 4, 2025, and the resulting changes were circulated in a new draft before this meeting. The items addressed at this meeting include the following:

- The laundering pre-conditioning step was moved to take place after the neck opening test to ensure the neck opening is measured at its largest size, to mitigate the risk of the occupant's head sinking into the opening.
- The neck opening test was revised such that products with adjustable neck openings will be adjusted to the age range(s) being tested, instead of to the largest size. This allows products with adjustable neck openings to span larger age ranges. Staff will monitor incident data for any potential issues related to this change, such as young infants submarining into products adjusted to an older age.

Next Steps

A new draft of the standard is expected to be balloted soon. Future meetings will be scheduled as needed.
