(PLI). PLI բ their official	This Directive establishes CPSC's policy on Professional Liability Insurance protects employees from losses in lawsuits stemming from the performance of duties. The Agency shall reimburse eligible employees for the purchase of PLI in not to exceed \$150 or 50% of the annual premium, whichever is less.
