### Summary of Meeting:

This Task Group (TG) meeting was to discuss a discrepancy of the location of the warning statement *“this product is not safe for sleep”* which is different in the infant swing standard from other similar juvenile products (e.g., bouncers, rockers). Currently, the warning *“this product is not safe for sleep”* is under the Fall and Strangulation hazard heading in the swing standard, whereas it is under the Suffocation hazard heading in the bouncers and rockers standards. The group discussed moving the warning statement from the Fall and Strangulation heading to the Suffocation hazard heading. One concern raised was that the Suffocation hazard category is only required for certain product designs, so moving the *“this product is not safe for sleep”* warning statement under the Suffocation heading would not make it required for those other product designs. The group agreed to move the statement under the suffocation heading, however, make the Suffocation hazard category required for all product designs. Additional warning statements would then be added to the Suffocation hazard heading depending on their design.

Another topic of discussion was whether the first word of one bullet in the warning statements should be in bold letters, similar to all of the other first words. Neither CPSC staff nor the members had a preference.

The TG Lead will clean up the proposal and present it to the CPSC staff and subcommittee for feedback.
