### Summary of Meeting:

The NFPA Technical Committee on Fire Prevention Organization and Deployment (FID-AAA) is Committee with primary responsibility for voluntary standards covering the organization, operation, deployment, and evaluation of code enforcement, public fire and life safety education, plan review, and fire investigation operations. The committee also has responsibility for voluntary standards related to developing the process to conduct Community Risk Assessments and Reduction Programs.

CPSC staff was recently added to this committee and has a primary interest in the Standard on Community Risk Assessment and Community Risk Reduction Plan Development (NFPA 1300).

The committee met for the first time in several years and reviewed public inputs to NFPA 1300 as well as NFPA 1452 – Guide for Training Fire Service Personnel to Conduct Community Risk Reduction for Residential Occupancies and selected sections of NFPA 1730 - Standard on Organization and Deployment of Fire Prevention Inspection and Code Enforcement, Plan Review, Investigation, and Public Education Operations.

Staff monitored the discussions on the public inputs to NFPA 1300.

NFPA Staff will incorporate committee feedback and issue a ballot later in 2024.
