Summary of Meeting:

CPSC staff is working with stakeholders to form an independent joint task force on IAQ and gas ranges. This task force would focus on making recommendations to various affected voluntary standards and code bodies to improve IAQ in homes from emissions from gas ranges. This was a meeting of Group 2 (focused on compiling a list of existing health reference values for NO<sub>x</sub>, CO, and PM 2.5) co-chaired by Charon McNabb and John Park.

The group reviewed two proposals, one from Andee Krasner and one by Brittany Meyer and Jonathan Wilson. CPSC staff actively participated in the discussion by comparing the two proposals. Offline by email, Andee Krasner supported the proposal by Brittany Meyer and Jonathan Wilson. The group decided to prepare an email to all Group 2 participants, asking if each participant supports or does not support the proposal. If consensus is reached, results will be shared at the next full task force meeting in April 2023.
