Summary of Meeting:

CPSC staff is working with stakeholders to form an independent joint task force on IAQ and gas ranges. This task force would focus on making recommendations to various affected voluntary standards and code bodies to improve IAQ in homes from emissions from gas ranges. This meeting was a continuation of monthly meetings held since September 2021. Scott Ayers chaired the meeting.

Scott Ayers provided an update on Group 1 activities (focused on compiling a list of existing North American voluntary standards and codes that may be applicable, including section numbers when appropriate, and mechanism to submit a proposal). There were no updates.

Charon McNabb did not provide an update on Group 2 activities (focused on compiling a list of existing health reference values for NOx, CO, and PM 2.5). Group 2 will next meet on Monday March 20th and is finalizing a recommendation.

Shannon Corcoran provided an update on Group 3 activities (focused on defining foreseeable and realistic exposure conditions, measurement methods, and time frames that could be used as the basis of a performance test method). Group 3 sent out a request for information to several testing laboratories. Shannon is in the process of hearing back from the testing laboratories. Several laboratories have reached out to her recently to discuss the request for information. Group 3 will next meet on April 13th to discuss responses.

Stakeholders asked CPSC staff questions on the recent CPSC Request for Information on Gas Ranges (RFI). Staff was unable to answer many of the direct questions, but stakeholders were interested to know public results for the RFI. Staff expects that the CPSC's next steps will be publicly shared when determined.

Stakeholders discussed the US DOE gas range efficiency rulemaking. The rulemaking comment period closes on April 3rd. CPSC staff will attempt to reach out to the DOE point of contact before the comment period closes to see how their rulemaking aligns with this group's efforts.

Scott Ayers proposed focusing a future meeting on research gaps. After discussion, the group decided to tentatively plan to focus the June meeting on current research and research gaps. Development of a test method currently considered by Group 3 would not be included in this June meeting. Stakeholders interesting in building the agenda should contact Scott Ayers.
