4,500

estimated Halloween-related injuries from October through November 2018.



44%

of the injuries were related to pumpkin carving activities.

25%

were due to falls while putting up or taking down decorations, tripping on costumes, or walking while trick-or-treating.

27%

of the injuries included lacerations, ingestions, and costume, pumpkin or decoration-related injuries.

4%

were due to allergic reactions or rashes.
