Subject: Proposal for Changes to ISO 10131 Foldaway beds - Safety requirements and tests

Dear Mr. Fossi and Mr. Tacca:

While investigating foldaway beds in the U.S. marketplace, U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) staff¹ found instances of insufficient mounting instructions, as well as instances in which necessary hardware was not included with the product. These situations have led to consumers' deaths and injuries due to improper installation. Therefore, CPSC staff requests the ISO Technical Committee review the installation requirements in ISO 10131-1 and consider the following:

- 1) CPSC staff suggests that the bed mounting installation instructions in Section 5 require that the product documentation include:
 - a. Detailed mounting instructions for that model foldaway bed, which state the specific type(s) of wall structures (*e.g.*, such as wood studs, metal studs, cement blocks) to which the product is intended to be mounted. The instructions should include appropriate illustrations to depict proper installation considerations.
 - b. A specific list of the hardware supplied with the model, or the hardware needed, to properly anchor the foldaway bed structure into the applicable wall system(s).
- 2) CPSC staff suggests defining a "competent person" used in Section 6, as a professional installer who has been "certified" by an appropriate governmental or private body, or is "authorized by" or "received training" from the manufacturer, retailer, or other third party.

I am available to answer any questions that the technical committee has on these identified issues. I look forward to helping you improve the safety of these products.
