This meeting was led by the Chair of the task group, Jarrod Kuhn, Sterno. A summary of the meeting is below.

The task group continued discussions from the April 7, 2026, meeting around the title of the draft standard for lamp, torch, and candle devices. Several members from the ASTM Subcommittee F15.45 on Candle Products attended the task group meeting. A torch fuel manufacturer mentioned that the task group revised the title of the draft standard as well as the introduction to clarify that the intent of the standard is to cover oil candles and not wax candles so that those purchasing the standard would see what type of standard they're purchasing – to show which products the standard applies to. Several members of the candle subcommittee responded that the modifications help. However, one of the candle subcommittee members expressed concern about whether the standard applies to jel wax candles. The torch fuel group responded that they are excluded from the standard. The group then discussed whether solid wax candles melting into a liquid are covered by the standard to which the torch fuel task group responded that they are not covered by the standard. The torch fuel task group resolved to clarify the intent of the standard in the "scope" section of the standard since purchasers of the standard will see not only the title but the scope. Members of the candle subcommittee requested a copy of the title and scope of the standard to show other candle subcommittee members who were not present at the meeting.
