Summary of Meeting: This meeting was led by the subcommittee chair, Eric Childs. After approval of the agenda and previous meeting minutes, the subcommittee began discussing recent work done by the Scope Task Group, which is exploring options to combine ASTM F2236 (Soft Infant and Toddler Carriers) and ASTM F2907 (Sling Carriers). The task group has been examining products on the market to determine what language will be needed to ensure that all relevant products are in-scope. CPSC staff requested to be added to this task group. The discussion then moved to a summary incident data recently provided by CPSC staff. This data includes hip carrier incidents occurring between 1/1/2020 and 1/1/2026, as well as sling carrier incidents occurring between 1/1/2023 and 12/1/2025. CPSC staff clarified that certain incidents categorized as “hip carrier” incidents involves soft infant and toddler carriers that have some sort of hip carry mode/function (these incidents are marked as such in the spreadsheet provided to ASTM).

Next Steps: The next subcommittee meetings are scheduled for October 26-28, 2026. Task group work is ongoing. CPSC staff will participate in future subcommittee and task group meetings.
