Summary of Meeting:

Victoria Delker of Continental Engineering Services requested a meeting with CPSC staff to discuss Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) research and regulations. Continental Engineering Services staff asked what the mission of agency is and the relationship with the OHV industry. CPSC responded with an overview of agency mission, which products fall within the scope of the agency, and brief description of the various functions of the agency such as recalls and the role of the Compliance division.

When asked about CPSC staff interactions with OHV industry groups, CPSC staff responded that CPSC staff regularly reaches out to industry groups such as SVIA (Specialty Vehicle Institute of America) to share information on incidents and any new research published by CPSC. CPSC staff mentioned OHV injury and death statistical reports are published annually and these reports are also provided to groups such as SVIA.
