#### **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

- The purpose of this meeting was for the Portable Generator Manufacturers Association (PGMA) to review the latest draft of the proposed revisions in the PGMA G300 standard, *Safety and Performance of Portable Generators* with PGMA's technical committee, steering committee, and canvass committee.
- Joe Harding led the discussion by going line-by-line through the draft revisions to G300 that was dated May 19, 2017, providing some explanation for each revision. Some of the revisions were not completely drafted, but served as placeholder for future input.
- Participants provided feedback on a number of the proposed revisions for future consideration by the PGMA technical committee. Staff suggested that PGMA include written rationale with some of the revisions to benefit the canvass committee members when G300 is canvassed again.
