Purpose: To align on Altana’s potential role in supporting eFiling and assess opportunities to integrate its supply chain data capabilities with CPSC’s compliance and pre-import risk assessment efforts.

Key Discussions Points:

- **Overview / Context:** Discussion highlighted Altana’s role in eFiling as part of broader supply chain visibility. Altana provides an AI-driven network connecting enterprises, logistics providers, and governments, aiming for a shared “library of known goods” across stakeholders.
- **Product Data / Supply Chain Visibility:** Altana links products to facilities and compliance attributes, adding network intelligence beyond static systems. Challenges include non-standardized data and tariff-focused HTS codes.
- **Account access for testing:** Altana may set up developer account for the Product Registry.
- **Testing Approach:** Altana will test eFiling with importer partners using test messages, Altana IDs, and pre-import compliance checks. Early voluntary participants are better positioned for full implementation.
