Key Discussions Points:

- **PGA Reject error messages in response to an entry filing** - There is a known CPSC issue causing four different error messages for Full PGA Message Set filings. Trade can safely ignore if all required data has been submitted correctly. If receiving a “Referenced Product was not found” error, trade should ensure that the three certificate identifiers submitted (Product ID, Version ID and Certifier ID) match exactly with a corresponding value stored in the Product Registry.
- **If CPSC can view corrected data** - In cases where incorrect data is submitted by trade and later corrected, CPSC can view updated PGA correction on their end.
- **Intended Use Code need for Disclaim** - Intended Use Codes are required on disclaims to assist CPSC in determining whether the disclaim was used appropriately. Disclaims are optional as decided by the Commission and not required.
- CPSC confirmed multiple products can be added in a single entry line.
