Summary of Meeting:

This task group was formed to discuss the potential development of a new standard for children's beds. The task group was formed based on a staff request following entrapment incidents in children's beds using a twin size or larger mattress, including a recalled Montessori-style bed.¹ The task group discussed various aspects that could be used to determine the scope of the draft standard, including:

- Age of intended users being 12 or under.
- Although the size of the bed was discussed as a potential factor, staff and other participants noted that incidents are not limited to a single size bed.
- Bed attributes to consider include guard rails, bed height, and the presence of gates.

Staff provided business guidance to the task group related to children's products.² The task group also developed a list of voluntary standards that could be referenced, including ASTM F1427 (bunk beds), ASTM F1821 (toddler beds), BS 8509 (children's beds), and NF D60-300 (furniture for children).

Next Steps:

Future task group meetings are expected to take place the third Thursday of every month.
