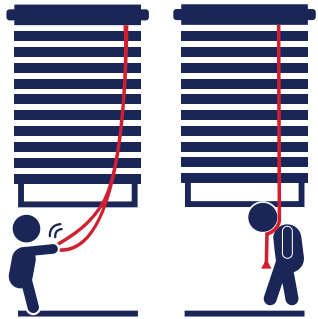
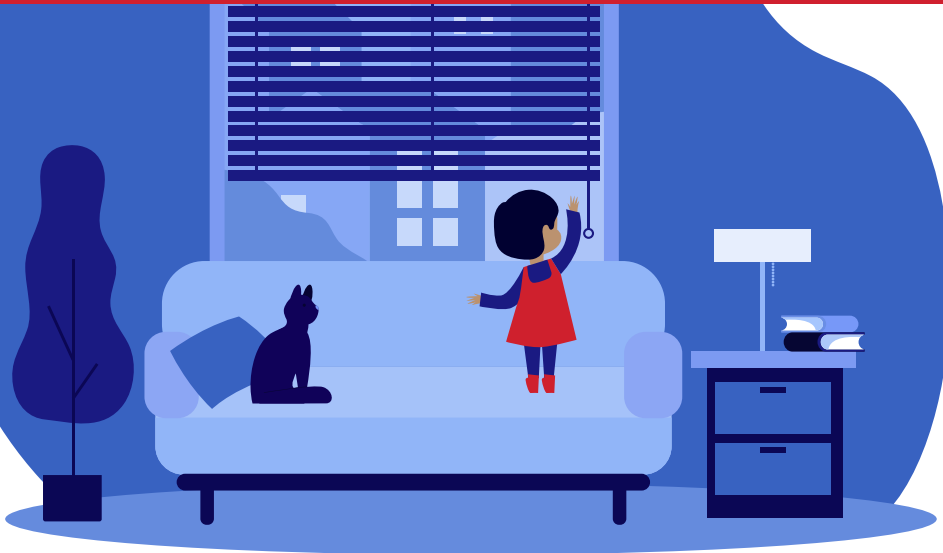


Prevent Child Strangulation

Go Cordless with Window Coverings

On average, about **8 children** aged 8 and under die every year from strangling in window blinds, shades, draperies and other window coverings with cords.



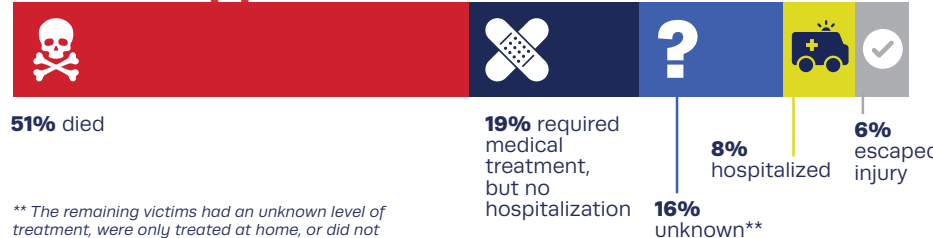
There have been over **230 incidents** involving children up to 8 years old due to strangulation hazards from window covering cords.*



Injuries varied from a scar around the neck, quadriplegia, and permanent brain damage.

What happened to the children?



** The remaining victims had an unknown level of treatment, were only treated at home, or did not require treatment.

What to do?
Go Cordless—the safest option.

- Buy and install cordless window coverings, which are available at most major retailers.
- When buying online, make sure the product is described as cordless.
