Petition Requesting Rulemaking on Magnet Sets; Reopening of the Comment Period

AGENCY: Consumer Product Safety Commission.

ACTION: Reopening of comment period.

SUMMARY: On October 6, 2017, the Consumer Product Safety Commission (Commission or CPSC) published a notice in the *Federal Register*, inviting the public to submit comments about a petition that Zen Magnets, LLC filed with CPSC. The petition requested that the Commission initiate rulemaking under the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA) to adopt a safety standard for high-powered magnet sets. The notice invited the public to submit written comments during a 60-day comment period beginning on the notice publication date. The day before the comment period closed, the Commission received a request for an extension of the comment period. In response to that request, the Commission is reopening the comment period for [] days.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

On October 6, 2017, the Commission published a notice in the *Federal Register* regarding a petition that Zen Magnets, LLC submitted to the Commission. The petition requested that the Commission initiate rulemaking to adopt a safety standard for high-powered magnet sets under Sections 7 and 9 of the CPSA (15 U.S.C. 2056, 2058) to address the hazard associated with these products if ingested, aspirated, or otherwise inserted into the body. The notice provided a 60-day comment period, which closed on December 5, 2017. On December 4, 2017, Zen Magnets, LLC requested that the Commission extend the comment period. The Commission has considered Zen Magnets, LLC's request and is reopening the comment period for [] days.
