

SAFER PLAYGROUNDS, SAFER PLAY FOR KIDS

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- 1 Never allow anyone to attach ropes, jump ropes, clotheslines, or pet leashes to play equipment. Children can strangle on these.
- 2 INSTALL AND MAINTAIN A SHOCK-ABSORBING SURFACE LIKE WOOD CHIPS, MULCH OR SAND AROUND THE PLAY EQUIPMENT.
- 3 MAKE SURE EQUIPMENT IS NOT TOO HOT FOR CHILDREN TO PLAY ON.
- 4 Make sure play equipment appears maintained and is not broken.
- 5 Carefully supervise children on play equipment to make sure they are safe.
