Petition to Amend Statement of Interpretation and Enforcement Policy Regarding Labeling of Household Products Containing Methylene Chloride (Briefing package dated May 26, 2017, OS No. 5703)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to grant the petition (HP 16-1) and direct CPSC staff to draft a policy statement that addresses labeling for acute hazards from inhalation of methylene chloride vapors. The petition from the Halogenated Solvents Industry Alliance, Inc., requests that the Commission amend the 1987 Statement of Interpretation and Enforcement Policy regarding labeling of household products containing methylene chloride to address acute hazards from inhalation of methylene chloride vapors in addition to chronic hazards.
