The May 26, 1994, meeting of the Consumer Product Safety Commission was convened in open session by Chairman Ann Brown. Commissioners Mary Sheila Gall and Jacqueline Jones-Smith were present.

## Agenda Item: 1994 Mid-Year Review

The Commission considered the allocation of agency resources for the balance of Fiscal Year (FY) 1994. On May 19, 1994, the staff briefed the Commission on the status of 1994 funds, programs, and projects and on proposed operating plan changes and funding proposals for the balance of the fiscal year. These matters were detailed in a briefing package dated May 5, 1994, from the Executive Director.

At today's meeting, on motion of Commissioner Gall, the Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to redirect the \$40,000 originally budgeted for information and education activities on five-gallon buckets to fund Consumer Information's Vulnerable Populations project.

The Commission then voted unanimously (3-0) on motion of Chairman Brown to approve the proposals for allocation of agency resources for the balance of FY 1994 as detailed in the staff's briefing package of May 5, 1994, and as amended here today.

Chairman Brown also addressed the need for a mechanism for alerting the Commission if additional funds become available during the remainder of the fiscal year. She directed the Executive Director, should additional funds from the FY 1994 budget become available, to discuss the recommendations for allocation with each Commissioner; and attempt to reach a consensus informally, without the need for a formal meeting. Commissioner Gall and Commissioner Jones-Smith stated concurrence with this procedure.
