ITEM:

ASTM's Notice of a Revised Voluntary Standard for Stationary Activity Centers
(Ballot vote package dated March 12, 2025, OS No. 0365)

DECISION:

The Commission voted (4-1) to accept ASTM F2012-24 as the new mandatory standard for stationary activity centers and publish the draft *Federal Register* notice to revise the version of the standard incorporated by reference in 16 C.F.R. part 1238. Acting Chair Feldman and Commissioners Boyle, Dziak and Hoehn-Saric voted to accept ASTM F2012-24 as the new mandatory standard for stationary activity centers.

Commissioner Trumka voted to determine that ASTM F2012-24 does not improve the safety of stationary activity centers and direct CPSC staff to notify ASTM of this determination and that the Commission is retaining the existing standard for stationary activity centers in 16 CFR part 1238.
