Airless Paint Spray Guns, CP 75-4

DECISION

The staff will identify the manufacturers, private labelers, and distributors of airless spray guns being primarily marketed for use by consumers that could, in the staff's judgment, present a substantial hazard to consumers. Notices of Enforcement will then be written for Commission approval, informing said parties of the Commission's intention to conduct a hearing (or hearings) pursuant to Sec. 15(f) of the CPSA to determine whether or not the products do present a substantial product hazard.
