Jurisdiction of Commission to Ban Pressurized Products Containing Fluorocarbon Compounds (CP 75-8 - Natural Resources Defense Council Petition Relating to Ozone)

DECISION

The Department of Justice is preparing for the Task Force established by the Council on Environmental Quality a discussion of the authority of the various governmental agencies to deal with the possible threat outlined in the petition.

The Commission will review that Department of Justice analysis along with that from the Commission staff and other sources before making a final determination on jurisdiction. No one source's views will be binding, but the issue is sufficiently complex to require all available information prior to a final determination.
