Bicycle Regulation

DECISION

- Because 1) The Commission did not put out for comment a proposed effective date for the bicycle regulation published July 16, 1974, and
- 2) Because an effective date of January 1, 1975, would appear to put unreasonable burdens on both domestic & foreign manufacturers in terms of meeting certain of its technical requirements,

the Commission decides to propose for comment an effective date of May 1, 1975. In addition, the Commission will publish for comment those sections of the regulation the Commission believes to be substantive changes from the original proposal and a "date of manufacturer" labeling requirement to be effective May 1, 1975.
