DECISION

of Dr. Staples unfinished term, the Commission agrees that Mr. DeWallace
will be given automatic reconsideration by the Commissioners for appoint-
ment to a full term. This means that his name will be among those pre-

that will occur in mid-1976. If Mr. DeWallace declines the appointment,
the Secretary is authorized to offer appointment under the same conditions
to Leonard Steiner.
